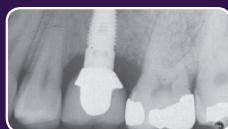
Course Co-director

Dr. John DiPonziano has been performing the surgical placement and prosthetic restoration of dental implants since the mid-eighties. He is a Certified Dental Technician, a Master of the Academy of General Dentistry, a Fellow of the International Congress of Oral Implantologists, and a Fellow of the American College of Dentists. He served as President of the New Jersey Academy of General Dentistry in 2003, and Chaired the Academy of General Dentistry's Implantology Task Force, which formulated universal educational guidelines for implant training in 2009.

Dr. DiPonziano maintains a private practice where he performs surgical as well as restorative dental implant procedures and full mouth rehabilitation in San Leandro, California.

Course Description
